

TEST NDT, Introduction to Ultrasonic Phased Array Course (16 Hours)

This is an overview course designed to familiarize the attendees with the basic concepts of Ultrasonic Phased Array Technology. It is intended for people who may not need to use Phased Array as an inspection tool personally, but, would like to be familiar with the basic concepts, advantages and limitations of the technique.

It would be suitable for managers considering expansion into the phased array technology or individuals who are interested in expanding their overall NDT knowledge.

This is not a course required by, or leading to certification.

This training package covers the same material covered in the first 2 days of the level 1 phased array training.

Attendees who successfully complete the introduction to phased array course may also attend the last 3 days of the level 1 phased array course at a later date, if desired to complete the 40 hour level 1 course, although this is not a mandatory requirement for attendees of the introduction course.
